Individuals to interview and videotape and loaned artifacts will be selected by March 1, 2010. Artifacts will be exhibited from November 2010 through March 2011 as part of the main exhibit.

All responses will be considered, but only a few will be chosen to participate in the project. The more information a candidate has to offer, the more likely he or she will be selected to participate.

Any artifacts, photos, or documents lent to the project will be exhibited from November 2010 through March 2011.

The interviews will be held on two dates to be scheduled in 2010, and as such, availability may inhibit a candidate’s ability to participate. In the event that a chosen participant is not available for the interview, the next available candidate will be contacted. All interviewees will be asked to sign a form turning all rights to any information given in the interview over to the Wisconsin Veterans Museum, to be used by the Waukesha County Historical Society & Museum.
