at the Waukesha County Museum

Join us on **Saturday, November 8, 2014 from 9:30am - 3:30pm** for the **Cub Scout Event Day!** Cub Scouts of all levels can complete two programs in one day, and enjoy the unique resources and exhibits the museum has to offer. The Education Department staff will be facilitating the program and supplying all materials, so your group can simply focus on the fun! Scouts will be divided into groups by age/level and will rotate to participate in two programs.

Tigers, Bears, and Wolves

In the morning session, Cub Scouts will participate in the Awesome Artists program by mixing colors, completing a canvas painting, playing art games, and making silly sculptures! Requirements to be Completed: Tiger Elect. 4, 5, 15; Wolf Elect. 12; Bear Elect. 9.

In the afternoon session, Cub Scouts will participate in the History's Superheroes program and explore tall tales with games, artifact handling, obstacle course, and making puppets and props for a play! Requirements to be Completed: Tiger Elect. 14, 15, 17, 19, 21; Wolf Elect. 2; Bear Achievement 4.

Webelos

In the morning Citizen program, Webelos will explore our nation's past during the Revolutionary War and Civil War, fold and make a flag, and complete activities about being a citizen today. Requirement to be completed: All of the Webelo Citizen Badge except req. #8. **In the afternoon Artist program,** Webelos will paint on canvas, make a clay sculpture, create a crazy guitar sculpture, and play several art games! Requirements to be Completed: All of Webelo Artist Badge
