



Cub Scout Event Day

at the Waukesha County Museum

Join us on **Saturday, March 14, 2015 from 9:30am - 3:15pm** for the **Cub Scout Event Day!** Cub Scouts of all levels can complete two programs in one day, and enjoy the unique resources and exhibits the museum has to offer. The Education Department staff will be facilitating the program and supplying all materials, so your group can simply focus on the fun! Scouts will be divided into groups by age/level and will rotate to participate in two programs.

Tigers, Bears, and Wolves

In the morning session, Cub Scouts will participate in the All American program to discuss how the US was founded, the history of our national and state flags, and what it means to be a citizen today. Requirements to be Completed: Tiger Ach. 2F and 2D, Elect. 20 and 49; Bear Ach. 3; Wolf Ach. 2. **In the afternoon session,** Cub Scouts will participate in the Native American Culture program and complete games, crafts, and hold real artifacts as we explore clothing, homes, music, art, and toys from Native Americans. Requirements to be Completed: Tiger Elect. 3, 7, 17; Wolf Elect. 10; Bear Elect. 24.

Webelos

In the morning Geologist program, Webelos will complete an archaeological dig for artifacts, examine and make fossils, and explore various rocks and minerals. Requirement to be completed: All of the Webelo Geologist Badge. **In the afternoon Scientist program,** Webelos will venture on the wild side of science with crazy experiments with water, air, and motion! Requirements to be Completed: All of Webelo Scientist Badge

Fee: \$14 per participating child for the entire day (half day rate is \$7). Two adults per group are free, additional adults are \$3.50 each (50% discount).
