7.) You need 10 yards of fabric to make 2 dresses. How many furs do you need? $\qquad$ 5 furs $\qquad$
8.) How many fishhooks could you buy with 2 otter furs? $\qquad$ 20 fishhooks $\qquad$
9.) It is almost Winter, and you need to buy 4 new blankets. How many Wolverine furs do you need? $\qquad$ 8 Wolverine furs $\qquad$
10.) You are ready to settle move West to start a trading post of your own. You have 90 furs to purchase supplies. What would you buy? Explain your thinking!
